

# Coronavirus (COVID-19): UVA Health & UVA Children's Visitation Update Outpatient Surgery Center (Battle Building)

UVA Health & UVA Children's cares about the health of our patients, team members, community and our visitors. For everyone's safety, we are taking important steps to stop the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19).

## What steps are we taking?

### Step 1: Visitor Restrictions: Designated Visitors only

Each patient, or legal guardian, may name **one adult** (18 years or older) to be a Designated Visitor.

Patients, or legal guardian, coming for a procedure should be thinking about naming their Designated Visitor. Patients, or legal guardian, will be asked to provide this name and phone number when the nurse calls before the procedure.

**Before the procedure:** The Designated Visitor may stay with the patient

**During the procedure:** The Designated Visitor can wait in their car (preferred). Level D of the Lee Street Garage has an area for waiting.

- The Designated Visitor who is giving the patient a ride home must stay within 30 minutes of the hospital.

**After the procedure:** The Designated Visitor can be with the patient for home care instructions.

**Please Note:** Visitors **cannot** wait in the lobby, cafeteria or other public space. They must wait outside of the hospital (car, home, etc.).

### Step 2: Screening

Patients and visitors will be screened before entering the building to make sure they show no signs of being sick.

### Step 3: Requiring Masks

Visitors **must wear a mask at all times** while in any UVA Health building, including while they are in the room with the patient. If visitors are unable to wear a mask, please speak with a UVA team member at the building entrance.

**If visitors need to visit the restroom or cafeteria, they should return to their waiting area as soon as possible.**
