

# Coronavirus (COVID-19): UVA Children's Visitation Update For Children Being Admitted After A Procedure

UVA Health cares about the health of our patients, team members, community and YOU, our visitor. For your safety, and those in our care, we are taking important steps to stop the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19).

## What steps are we taking?

### Step 1: Visitor Restrictions: Designated Visitors Only

Each child may have **two adults** (18 years or older) as their Designated Visitors.

**Please be thinking about who your child's Designated Visitors will be so you can provide their name and phone number when the nurse calls before their procedure.**

**Before the procedure:** One Designated Visitor may stay with the patient.

**During the procedure:** Designated Visitors may wait in open waiting areas. **Do not** wait in the lobby or other public space.  
Level D of the Parking Connector is available for waiting.

**During recovery:** One Designated Visitor may be with the patient during their recovery

**After the procedure:** One Designated Visitor can visit the patient once they are out of recovery and in a room, 24/7.

- **Designated Visitors can trade places one time each day.** When you trade, you may visit your child together briefly.

### Step 2: Screening

You will be screened before entering the building to make sure you show no signs of being sick.

### Step 3: Requiring Masks

**You must wear a mask at all times** while in any UVA Health building, including while you are in the room with a patient. If you are unable to wear a mask, please speak with a UVA team member at the building entrance.

### Step 4: Requiring Visitor Check-in

Before going up to the room to see the patient after the procedure:

- All visitors must check-in at the Main Lobby Information Desk to get visitor badge.
- You must show ID to receive a Visitor ID badge.
- Expect delays at check-in. We may ask you to be seated for a short time.
- **You will not be allowed in patient care areas without a Visitor ID badge.**

**If you need to visit the restroom or cafeteria, please return to your waiting area as soon as possible.**
