Course Description/Learning Objectives:

The Healer's Art is a curriculum designed by Rachel Naomi Remen, MD, Director of the Institute for the Study of Health and Illness at Commonweal, and Professor of Family and Community Medicine at UCSF School of Medicine, to address "the hidden crisis in medicine, the growing loss of meaning and commitment experienced by physicians nationwide under the stress of today's health-care system." She has taught this to practicing physicians in workshops across the country and developed a course for medical students that has been adopted by medical schools throughout the U.S., including UVa. In this one-day program, the UVa faculty who teach the course will focus on the following themes: 1. Discovering and Nurturing Your Wholeness, 2. Sharing Grief and Honoring Loss, 3. Beyond Analysis: Allowing Awe in Medicine, 4. The Care of the Soul: Service as a Way of Life. **This year's course includes a greater emphasis on Grief, Loss, and Healing.** At the end of this program, participants will be able to: describe techniques of stress reduction and physical, emotional, and spiritual self-care; list strategies for processing grief; describe a framework to discuss the awe and mystery of medicine, particularly in end-of-life care; and examine service as a way of life.

Course Fee: \$100, includes continental breakfast, lunch, and materials (**NOTE: there is no charge for UVa faculty/staff but registration is required**).
