

The Marjorie and Jaye Grollman Visiting Lectureship in Cardiology

Dr. Jaye Grollman (1909-1986) received his M.D. degree from the University of Maryland and training in obstetrics and gynecology at Baltimore City Hospital and the University of Nebraska, respectively. He then undertook basic endocrinology research in collaboration with his brother, Dr. Arthur Grollman, at Johns Hopkins. He subsequently started a private practice in OB-GYN in Washington, D.C., where he was on the staff of the Washington Hospital Center. Forty-five years later, he retired to a second career in farming in Gordonsville, Va. Marjorie Grollman received her B.S. degree from the University of Maryland in 1941. She then underwent dietetic training at the University of Maryland, after which she served as a nutritionist at the Union Memorial Hospital in Baltimore.
