**OLD BUSINESS**

- A library advisory group has been created to better support the library with feedback and changes
- Supplemental Funding requests:
- Supplemental Funding requests:
  - Rad Onc Club is asking for additional \$100 for fall interest meetings
    - They already received \$100 for this semester
    - They have 35 members confirmed for the meetings
    - Mulholland usually fully funds new organization
    - Outcome: additional \$50 granted with recommendation that they seek alternative support from the Rad Onc Dept.
  - ENT club is asking for \$90 for a fall interest group meeting
    - Miscommunication by their members, they did not submit the initial funding request
    - It is unknown if they receive funding from their department in the past
    - Outcome: \$90 was granted for a fall interest meeting

    - Some concern was discussed that we may not be able to fund our other projects with tight budgets
    - Outcome: \$250 was suggested as an appropriate amount from the Mulholland society, since many of our students do go to the event and enjoy the lights
