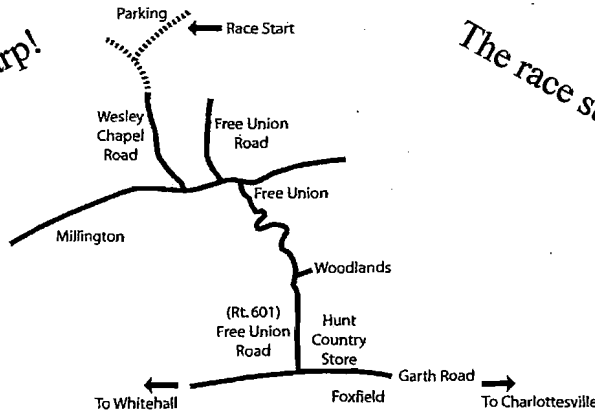

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Course: This gently rolling course takes the runners along a beautiful country road featuring panoramic views of the mountains.
