The morning of Saturday, February 6th will consist of classroom training at the Best Western Charlottesville, Virginia. The following topics are being covered:

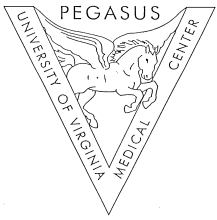
- **FORMING AND IMPLEMENTING A POST ACCIDENT INCIDENT PLAN**
- **PERSONAL SURVIVAL EQUIPMENT AND SURVIVAL KITS**
- **STORY OF SURVIVAL: "MAXIMUM IMPACT CRASH"**
- **EMERGENCY MENTAL PREPAREDNESS**
- **SHELTER BUILDING AND FIRE STARTING**
- **OVER WATER EMERGENCIES**
- **GROUND UNIT SURVIVAL**

The Saturday afternoon session will consist of field exercises and overnight training on private land in the mountains of Madison County, Virginia. This property is bordered by the Shenandoah National Park and tends to run 10-15 degrees cooler than the nearby urban areas. Weather is unpredictable, so please come prepared! Emergency equipment that is generally found on the aircraft will be provided to you for your utilization. Participants should bring survival equipment that they would normally carry on their person and a sleeping bag. The wearing of your official work uniform is strongly encouraged to enhance the realism of your overall experience. Once you are registered you will receive an official confirmation via email with a detailed outline of everything you will need to bring with you.

## **Course Fee: \$175.00**

Course fee includes: Instructional materials, survival memorabilia, supplies and food for the entire weekend. The Madison Women's Auxiliary is graciously catering a breakfast for everyone during the course wrap-up session on Sunday the 7th. Showers will also be available if needed prior to your departure.
